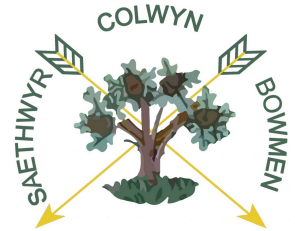

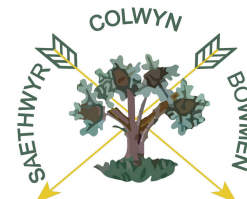

Rules of shooting As a World Record Status event (pending approval) this tournament will be shot to Archery GB rules (timing to Method 2 with lights), competitors must comply with Archery GB's dress regulations - rule 307

Assembly at 08.45am  
Shooting starts at 09.00am

- WA720 (qualification round)  
- H2H (cut off will depends on entries received)

Sunday  
- WA720 (qualification round)  
- H2H (cut off will depends on entries received)

Compound archers shoot on 80cm 5-X faces, all other styles on 122cm face 1-X.

Drug testing Archers competing at the Record Status event will be liable for drug testing. Competitors approached to give samples must comply. Any refusal will be treated as a positive result. If you are entering a minor into this competition you consent to the testing of that minor; this is in line with the UK Anti-Doping Policy, Rule 5.7.2.
